BOD MINUTES of Meeting: November 12, 2024

The Board meeting was called to order by President Becky Hopson.

Board Members/Committee Chairs Absent Greg Hain, Rick Johnson, Larry Scilley, Linda Rouhoff Other Day Makers, Members Present, Judy Zierdt and Dick Odell.

Approval of Agenda: Ruth Vrieze moved, and Jim Decker seconded the motion to approve the agenda. **Agenda was approved.**

Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting:

Helen Kolb made the motion to approve the minutes, of the meeting of November 12, 2024. Dave Bhaskaran seconded the motion. **Minutes were Approved.** It was moved by Dave Bhaskaran and seconded by Jim Schwinghammer to approve the November 2024 monthly report to Kiwanis International. **Motion was approved.**

<u>Treasurer's Report as of November 30, 2024:</u> The report was sent out to all board members in the packets before the meeting. Ruth Vrieze moved to accept the report as presented and Dave Bhaskaran seconded the motion. **Motion was Approved.**

OLD BUSINESS:

Jim Decker thanked the members of the club for the tremendous month of KWIK Trip gift card sales in November and early December. He announced that by the end of December (the first Quarter of the Kiwanis Year we will have earned a profit of \$4,000 so far for the 2024-2025 Kiwanis Year.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Jim Schwinghammer stated that he and Diane (Jim's wife) had gone shopping for the Jeremiah Program Winter Wishes 2024 project. He stated that they had purchased practical/useful items for the sponsorship of 1 Mom. He presented the bill of \$160.54 for reimbursement. At the November board meeting it had been approved that we sponsor up to \$150 in gifts. Since the amount was over the original approved amount Ruth Vrieze moved that we approve the presented bill with Jim Decker seconding the motion. **Motion Carried**

BOD Minutes:

Jack mentioned that the Club Bylaws that our club approved on October 24, 2024, were submitted on October 29, 2024, to Kiwanis International for approval. We received notice that Kiwanis International approved them on November 26, 2024. Jack also, stated that our annual dues were paid on December 2, 2024, in the amount of \$5,370.00. This was the revised amount from the original \$5,551.00. The revision was due to the increase from 3 to 6 spouse memberships that were given credit for the magazine reduction fees and the removal of Don Cain who had resigned after the original deadline.

NEW BUSINESS:

Jack brought up the request for payment of our annual \$1,000.00 payment to the RCTC Foundation for two \$500.00 scholarships. The request is for the 2025-2026 Academic School Year to be paid by February 1, 2025. However, the Foundation presently has a "Double Your Gift" opportunity at the present time. It is a Dollar-for-Dollar Match (up to \$1,000) until December 31st. The consensus of the board members was to pay the amount by the end of December.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

In Rick Johnson's absence mentioned that signup sheets for helping during Christmas Anonymous on Saturday December 14th, and leading up to the distribution day on Saturday the 14th have been completed by some of our members. In Linda Rouhoff's, absence during the report for the Early Childhood Development Committee, it was stated that the Pinewood Elementary School reading help program is now operational on Monday-Wednesday and Friday mornings at this time. Volunteers are needed to work with the young children. See Dave Bhaskaran or Janet Cederholm if you would like to volunteer.

Ruth Vrieze Human and Spiritual Aims Committee chairperson, reported that 10 cards had been sent since last month's board meeting. A Thinking of you card to Greg Hain on his rehab at Homestead.
