



BOD Minutes of Meeting: January 14, 2025

Board Members/Committee Chairs Absent Greg Hain, Rick Johnson, Linda Rouhoff, Ruth Vrieze, Other Day Makers, Members Present, Kathy Davis Approval of Agenda: Janet Cederholm moved, and Jim Cook seconded the motion to approve the agenda. Agenda was approved.

Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting: Larry Scilley made the motion to approve the minutes, of the meeting of December 10, 2024. Jim Decker seconded the motion. Minutes were Approved.


