**Approval of Agenda:** Dave Bhaskaran moved, and Ruth Vrieze seconded the motion to approve the agenda with the addition of July 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting Decision. **Agenda was approved.** 

# **Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting:**

### Day Makers New Member: Debbi Grogan

I was raised in Somers, NY and I worked at IBM in Fishkill. It was a wonderful learning experience. I graduated from Manhattanville College which is in Purchase, NY with a degree in Mathematics. I then attended Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (RPI) in Troy, NY where I received my Masters degree in Applied Mathematics. During my time at RPI, I met Tom Grogan. In January of 1977, I drove my Volkswagen Beetle from Somers to Rochester, MN in the middle of a blizzard (young and dumb, I guess).
